THIS AFFECTS EVERY OKLAHOMA BUSINESS — NOT JUST RESTAURANTS

- **Retail & shops:** Higher payroll = higher prices. Customers notice.
- **Construction & trades:** Wage compression squeezes every tier when the floor goes up.
- **Agriculture & farms:** SQ 832 removes the farm worker exemption. Family farms are directly targeted.
- **Healthcare & clinics:** Can't automate patient care. Costs get passed on or staff gets cut.
- **Childcare & education:** Thin margins. No way to absorb an unlimited escalator.
- **Trucking & logistics:** Driver wages already above \$15 — but the whole pay ladder shifts.
